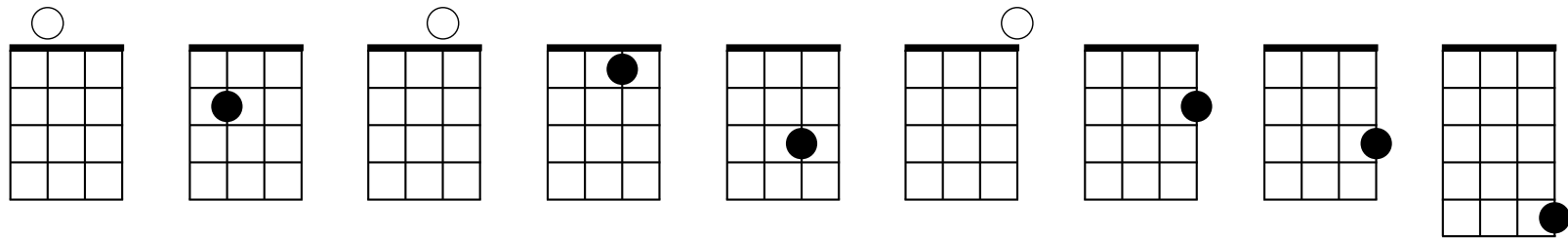

Notes on the ukulele fretboard

C6 tuning (g, c, e, a)
